To the Applicant:

Dr. Harley D. and Dorothy Hampe Scanlan were Sheldon residents many years ago. Dr. Scanlan had a chiropractic office in Sheldon before retiring to Spirit Lake, Iowa in 1953. Dr. Scanlan's wife, Dorothy Hampe Scanlan, in her Last Will and Testament, set aside the sum of \$60,000 to the Sheldon Community School Educational Foundation to be specifically used for a period of twenty-five years, commencing in the year 1996 for the purpose of awarding a scholarship in the minimum amount of \$3,500 to a student in the Sheldon Community School Senior Class who attends an institution of higher learning. The scholarship is based on (1) leadership; (2) future promise; (3) citizenship and (4) financial need. This fund is administered by the Sheldon Community School Foundation and the selection of the scholarship recipient is made each year by a special committee established by Dorothy Hampe Scanlan. After said twenty-five year period, the funds will be expended by the Sheldon Community School Educational Foundation for the purchase of playground equipment for the Sheldon Community Schools.
